


Figure 1. Thermal Response (Note 1)


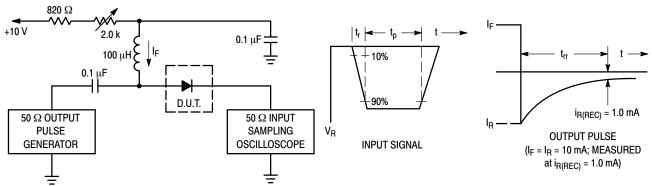


Figure 2. Thermal Response (Note 2)

Figure 3. Recovery Time Equivalent Test Circuit

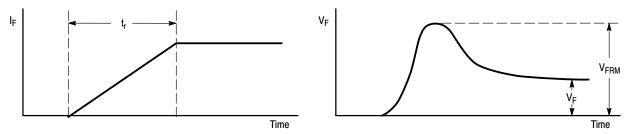



Figure 4. Peak Forward Recover Voltage Definition



Figure 6. Leakage Current







Figure 7. Average Forward Power Dissipation

Figure 8. Average Reverse Power Dissipation






Figure 9. Total Capacitance






