






Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics

Figure 2. Normalized On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 3. On–Resistance Variation with Temperature




Figure 4. On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 6. Switching Loss vs. Drain Current




Figure 7. Switching Loss vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage




Figure 8. Switching Loss vs. Gate Resistance




Figure 9. Switching Loss vs. Temperature




Figure 10. Reverse Drain Current vs. Body Diode Forward Voltage




Figure 11. Gate-to-Source Voltage vs. Total Charge




Figure 12. Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage




Figure 13. Unclamped Inductive Switching Capability




Figure 14. Maximum Continuous Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Figure 15. Safe Operating Area




Figure 16. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation


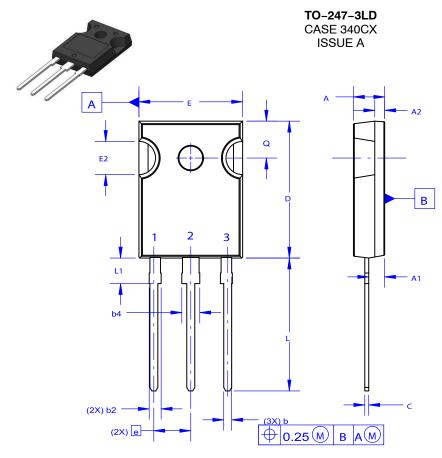


Figure 17. Junction-to-Case Transient Thermal Response

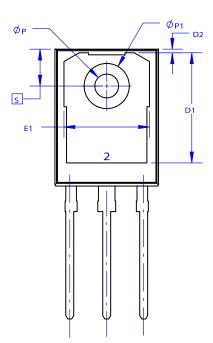
GENERIC MARKING DIAGRAM*
