






Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4. Diode Forward Voltage vs. Source Current




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area




Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Figure 11. Eoss vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage





Figure 12. Transient Thermal Impedance
