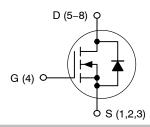

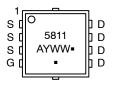
N-Channel MOSFET

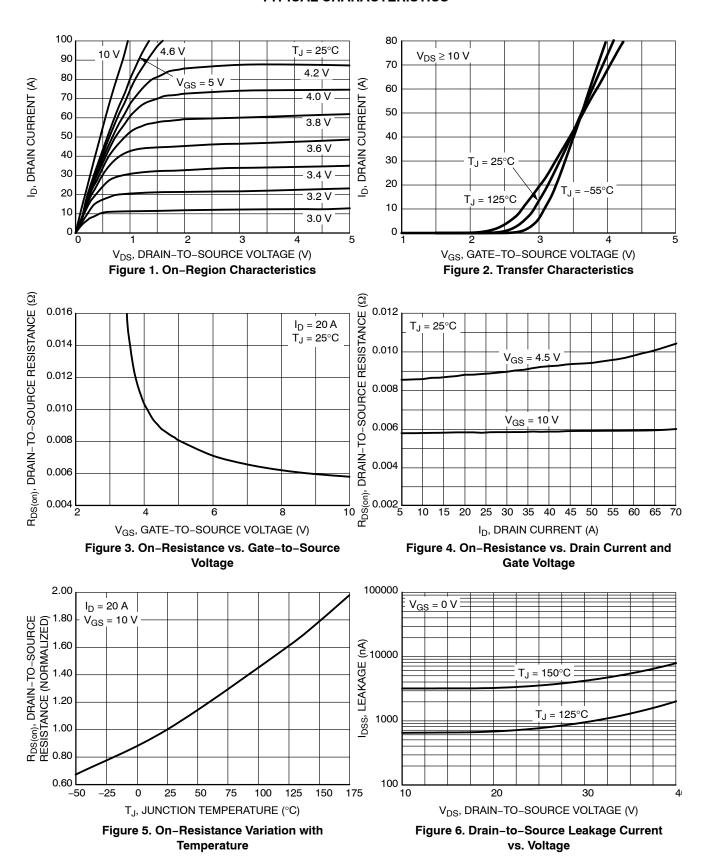

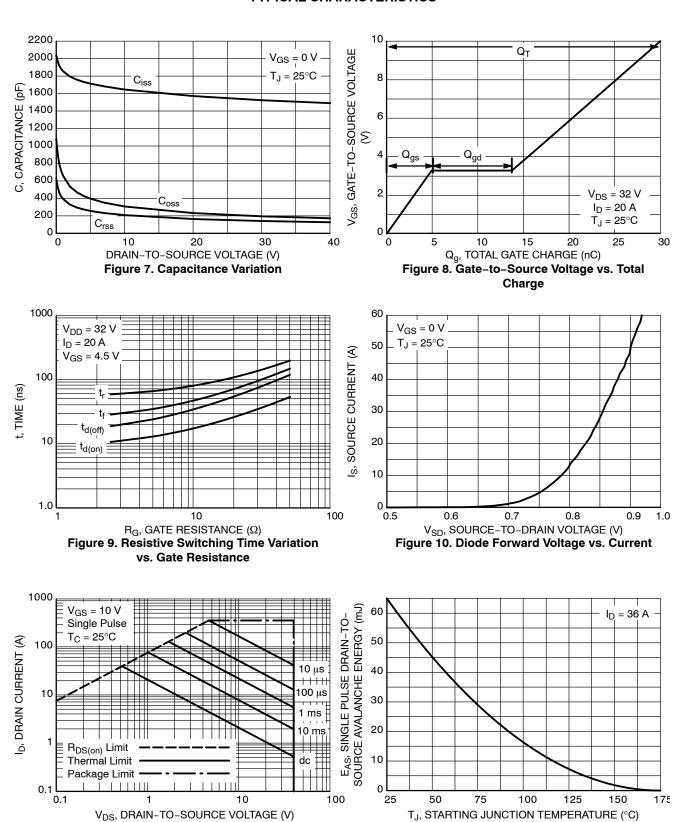


Figure 12. Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Starting Junction Temperature

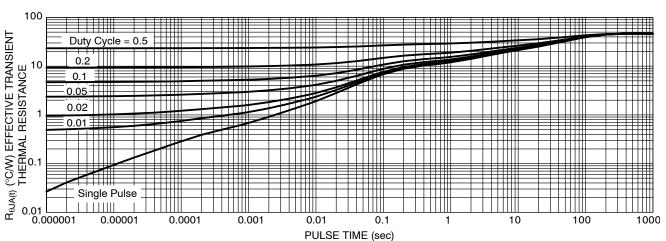


Figure 13. Thermal Response

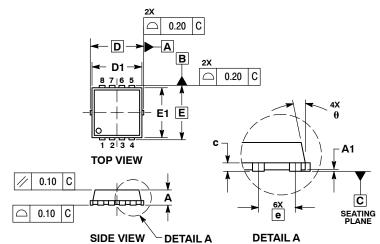

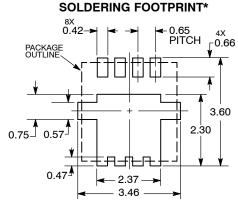


GENERIC MARKING DIAGRAM*
